- As credentialed and privileged to perform, physical examinations, histories, chart documentation, patient orders, radiological and laboratory interpretation, discharge orders, patient and family instruction and education, and participation in case management.
- Empowers and supports care givers and patients through education of the disease process and prescribed care regimens.
- Actively participate and collaborate in Hawai'i Care Choices Interdisciplinary Team, program development, special projects, and education.
